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FRAME ASSEMBLING BOX

To use the box

- 1. Make sure the two tapered wooden pegs are in position, but not tight.
- 2. Pick up ten end bars in your left hand and run a line of glue down the grooves where the top bars fit, and the grooves where the bottom bars fit.
- 3. Place the end bars, with the slots for the top bar facing up, in the box behind the wooden pegs. They will fit neatly in the shaped slots provided.
- 4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 with ten more end bars.
- 5. Put the top bars in position and nail securely.
- 6. Making sure your wooden pegs are secure enough to hold the partly assembled frames in position, turn the box upside down.
- 7. Release the wooden pegs just slightly.
- 8. Place bottom bars in position and nail securely.
- 9. Release the wooden pegs and withdraw.
- 10. Lift the assembly box straight up leaving the frames on your bench standing upside down on their top bars.
- 11. Place an empty super over them again upside down, and turn the lot, super and frames, the right side up. You now have ten frames neatly stacked in the super. This is the most effective way we know of making up frames in large or fairly large quantities
